Dutch Open Fryslân Synchro Masters Championship

HZ&PC Heerenveen has the pleasure to invite you to the 5th Fryslân Open Synchro Masters Championship. Also this year this championship will be combined with the Dutch National Synchro Masters Championship!

This Championship will take place on July 5th and 6th 2025.

Rules: Age shall be determined as of December 31 of the year of competition. The competitors must be 20 in 2025. The average age of the competitors in a routine shall be determined by adding the ages of the actual swimmers, divided by the number of swimmers (not including the reserves) and dropping any resulting fraction or decimal. For example, if the average age of a Team is 49.833, they would swim in the 35-49 age group

³ Teams shall consist of a minimum of four (4) members and a maximum of eight (8) members (Team). Combinations shall consist of a minimum of four (4) members and a maximum of ten (10) members (Combination).

Men can also participate. There will be a category “Mixed duet” and a category “Men” whatever the age of the participants. Men can also join in trio, team and combo. Multies are also welcome.





No Dutch National Synchro Masters Championship will be held in the age category 20 – 24 and the Combo event. Only the Fryslân Open Championship competition will be held in these events.

The Technical and Free Routine will be swum as separate events. A final ranking will be drawn up for both parts (Technical and Free Routine) for both the Fryslân Open Championship and the Dutch Masters Championship. A medal ceremony will also take place for both parts (Technical and Free Routine).

¹ There shall be no minimum time limit. Time limits include ten (10) seconds for the deck movement.

Participants are allowed to swim the technical routine during the free routine event.

Required elements for technical routine are the elements from FINA 2018-2022. Technical elements in solo and (mixed) duet have to be performed parallel to the judges.

During the technical routine, wearing a so-called “show” swimsuit, matching makeup and hair cap is permitted. There is therefore no obligation to wear a black swimsuit and white swimming cap during the technical routine!

Entries:

No limitation in number of solo’s, duo’s, teams, combo’s per category.

You can register for the Technical and/or the Free Routine separately.

For an optimized organization, one (1) judge per club is requested for clubs with ten (10) or less competitors, two (2) judges are required for clubs with more than ten (10) competitors. The fee to pay if you participate without judge (or only one judge for more than ten (10) competitors) is € 100,00. Judges participating in the Championships is allowed with the remark that :





- The judge cannot judge in events where the judge is also registered as participant.
- The judge is able to judge at least two events on both days.

Financial conditions:

Costs for travel and accommodation are borne by the participating clubs and/or participants

Fees:

- Solo €15.00 (Technical or Free Routine), €22.50 (Technical and Free Routine)
- (Mixed) Duet € 20.00 (Technical or Free Routine), € 30.00 (Technical and Free Routine)
- Team € 10.00 per participant (Technical or Free Routine), € 15.00 (Technical and Free Routine)
- Combo € 12.50 per participant (Free Routine)

Entry:

Registration opens: Friday February, 14th 2025
Preliminary entry: Before Monday April, 14th 2025
Final entry: Before Friday May, 24th 2025

Prel. Schedule:

Saturday, July 5th 2025
All Technical Routines

Sunday, July 6th 2026
All Free Routines

The schedule may be adapted based on the number of competitors.
A more detailed schedule will be sent after the preliminary entry has been closed.
